The influences of the accident at the nuclear power plant on GOO.N diapers

Daio Paper Corporation and our subsidiaries were not affected much by the earthquake that hit northern Japan, but we are working to get back to normal and to support the devastated areas. With regards to the accident at the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant caused by the earthquake, we have gotten some questions about the possibility that radioactive materials might be on GOO.N diapers thus cause health issues for the babies wearing them.

1. The factory that we manufacture GOO.N is in Ehime prefecture and is far from Fukushima prefecture; about 800 km. GOO.N is manufactured in a clean building with special equipment that prevent dust or foreign objects from coming inside. In addition, the shipping routes to each country are more than 30 km away from the nuclear power plant. It is not possible that our baby diapers have been exported to extraordinary radioactive material.
2. Since we have a responsibility to ensure the safety of our products and to give our customers peace of mind, we requested a technical inspection facility to measure the quantity of radioactive materials. The result indicated a few radioactive materials, as much as exists in the natural wood.

3. We bought machinery that measures radioactive materials, and added the inspection to our criteria of quality control. As below, we inspected GOO.N, which was manufactured from 18th to 24th in March, and the result obviously shows the safety of the products. Should there be any problems with our products, the products are never shipped.

Though the unprecedented disaster has left us all shaken, we are making doubly sure to manufacture GOO.N to the highest health standards. We appreciate your understanding, and please continue to use GOO.N in peace.
